Susan's story: needing a little more

When I was young people wondered why I was singing the wrong song lyrics. It seemed I was replacing the words with what it sounded like due to my hearing loss. I always thought Neil Diamond was singing about "Reverend Blue Jean" until a friend pointed out what the lyric actually is.

I now work as an advocate (IMHA / IMCA and Community). Much of my work involves meetings (tribunals, multi-disciplinary, team meetings etc.), face-to-face with clients, telephone work, training and group sessions. The biggest problem I face is when there is a large group of people in the same room, or working in groups around the table. My hearing aids were not effective in these situations; I found that extraneous sounds were amplified and distorted meaning I missed so much. I stopped attending these events as I was not feeling involved. I would go home exhausted, frustrated and feeling extremely isolated.

Choosing the right system

As part of the Access to Work scheme I tried the DigiSystem. I found the sound quality to be much better than other systems I had tried. The clarity of sound and adjustability of the system is wonderful. It reduces background noise and helps with clarifying speech. I tried a number of items for different working situations and I found some of them can be finely adjusted to suit your personal needs.

Improving performance

The piece of equipment I use most is the DC-20, which is really versatile for meetings, training and conferences. The added feature of being able to adjust the mic for omni-directional or zoom is great. My workplace is quite noisy at times; this system enables me to tailor the settings to suit the environment, meaning I can adapt to various situations. My work life is now much less stressful. I feel involved as much as any other employee. I no longer feel isolated and excluded. I can now attend training events again, even if there is group work. I am happier at work than I have been in a long time and feel fully able to perform all aspects of my role.
